



EQUIPMENT PURCHASE ISSUE

- In August UNIMED launched the tender procedure, compliant with the procedures and regulations of the Erasmus+ programme, but no offers were received.
- According to what stated by the PO, the equipment should be bought at latest 4
 months before the end of the Project, and that it should be used for activities to be
 implemented during the project and to reach the project objectives.
- Since the Project is running to the end, launching a new procedure is not an option at this stage and the expense is considered ineligible by EACEA.

BANK ACCOUNTS ISSUE

- Still an open issue.
- All previous proposals from Siena and UNIMED to the Iraqi MOHSR were not accepted.
- We have done everything possible taking into account the constraints imposed by European and Italian regulations regarding the management of public financial resources.
- Constant dialogue with EACEA, EU delegates and MOHSR
 - 25th October: meeting among the UNISI and UNIMED staff, the financial manager of the project, and our project officer at EACEA.
